### The Trips...

#### Revolution of Love **Revolution**

This Revolution is a revolution of LOVE. It's about taking Jesus' revolutionary love to the streets. It's about Christian teens living radically – like Jesus calls them to, making an impact here, now, serving the community and those in great need. It's about high school students from many different churches uniting as ONE for one cause: God's mission on this earth.

Revolution is a five-day high school only local impact mission trip. We come together to serve, to learn, to worship, to pray, and to love each other and the world around us.

Location: Camp Hickory, Ingleside, IL

Cost: \$200

#### Mission Charleston



YouthWorks is one of the premier short-term mission organizations for students. When serving with YouthWorks, students can expect to serve at places like: Children's Programs (like a Boys and Girls Club of America), Elderly Centers, Soup Kitchens/Homeless Shelters and Thrift Stores. The goal is to meet the very basic needs of residents, and thus build inroads to sharing the message and hope found in Jesus. Evening cultural activities will be a part of the mission experience.

The primary difference between Revolution and Mission Charleston is location and culture: Revolution offers an opportunity to serve locally, partnering with other local youth groups; Mission Charleston gives students a taste of serving in a slightly different culture, gaining awareness of the needs and lifestyle of people in another part of the U.S., trusting God outside of our cultural comfort zone.

Dates: July 11-16, 2010

Location: YouthWorks site, Charleston, West Virginia

Cost: \$250 (plus travel meal money, ~\$50)

Registration Deposit: \$50, with Application and Waiver

Registration Deadline: March 7, 2010

## The Fundraisers...

Fundraiser Dinner. We will be holding a Fundraiser Dinner on Sunday, May 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2010. Only those students who participate in the Fundraiser Dinner will benefit from its proceeds. The dinner will be open to the church, family, friends, and relatives. Students will help plan games, serve the meal, lead worship, and share about the trip. (Students in the past have earned about \$75 by helping out with this dinner.)

Servant Auction. Beginning May 2<sup>nd</sup>, the church will have the opportunity to hire students to perform various tasks and earn money for the trip. A student can earn as much as he or she is willing to work and as job opportunities allow! (Some students in the past have earned up to \$100 by working hard and being diligent about taking on jobs.)

Kids Night Out! Students will offer childcare (and a lot of fun games!) for kids 3 months – 12 years for 3 hours on Friday, May 21<sup>st</sup>; 5:30 – 8:30 pm. Parents can use the night as a date night or as time to just relax without the kids. Depending on interest and turnout, a student may be able to earn up to \$40 or more.

## The Application Process...

**1) Application. 2) Waiver. 3) Deposit. 4) Deadline.**

Fill out the enclosed Application and Waiver (or find them online at [thirdplacelife.com/events.html](http://thirdplacelife.com/events.html)) and return these with a \$50 non-refundable deposit (\$100 if participating in both trips) by March 7<sup>th</sup>, 2010. Applicants will be taken on a first-come, first-serve basis, assuming the application is approved and deposit received. There are 28 spots available for Revolution and 14 spots available for Mission Charleston. Don't wait to sign up!

## International Trip 2011 Requirement...

For those who want to participate in the 2011 International Trip (location tbd; ages: incoming 9<sup>th</sup> – outgoing 12<sup>th</sup>, with potential for room for some college students), that student must have been part of another mission trip with Third Place/TCC. Both Revolution and Mission Charleston count toward this requirement.
